

Psalm 4 To the leader of the choir. A Psalm of David

2. Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness! Thou gavest me freedom, when I was confined: have mercy upon me and hearken unto my prayer.

3. O ye sons of the powerful, how long will you profane my glory, loving vanity, and seeking lies? 4. Know that the Lord Himself has set aside His Glory and chosen Him; the Lord hears when I call unto Him.

5. *When angered, do not sin: ruminant in your own heart upon your bed, and be still.* 6. *Offer righteous sacrifices, and trust in the Lord.*

7. Many say, Who will show us good things? Reveal to us the light of Thy Face, Lord! 8. Thou filled my heart with gladness, while their wheat, wine, and oil did abound.

9. In peace I will lay me down and sleep: for Thou, Lord, makest me to dwell in safety.
